

# Platform

1. Fold your base card in half. Crease the fold of the base card. Set aside your base card.



2. Cut out your 3 rectangles. Fold them each in half and crease each of the two tabs. Fold each of the tabs. Use a paper clip or a pencil to score your dotted line. A ruler can serve as a guide so that your line is straight.



3. Line up the center fold of one rectangle with the spine of your base card. Use a pencil to mark one side of the rectangle. This serves as a guide as you glue.



4. Fold back the bottom tab. Line up this fold on your pencil line. Apply glue to the tab. Close the base card.

5. Close the rectangle so it looks like a square (but with the tab out.) Apply glue to the outside of the tab. Close the card.



6. Close the base card. The tent should be symmetrical



7. Apply glue to the outside of a tab. Line it up with the top of one side of the tent. Close the base card.



8. Fold up this 2<sup>nd</sup> tab. Apply glue to the outer surface of the tab. Close base card. You will end up this.



9. Repeat steps 7 & 8 on the other side.

10. This is the final platform.
